

LODGE HOST & CARETAKER

Powderpigs, located on Snoqualmie Pass, WA is hiring a Lodge Host & Caretaker for the 2019-20 winter season.

Role:

The Lodge Host & Caretaker is responsible for ensuring that the school lodge (the "Pigpen") is a clean and welcoming environment prior to, during and after lessons, for our school community. This includes cleaning duties, garbage and recycle monitoring, helping ensure the hot chocolate doesn't run dry, restocking restroom supplies as needed, and maintaining a clean environment during business hours. This position may help with store sales, sitting with students who come in cold, or helping monitor students needing to come inside briefly. This position will help with set up and tear down of class signs, fences or obstacle courses before and after lessons. Overall, the primary function of this position is to help ensure that all of our school families have an enjoyable and pleasant experience while they are on the mountain and that the management team is supported both inside and outside of the school lodge.

The Lodge Host & Caretaker works with and reports to the management team. This position is a weekend shift, working Friday evenings (4pm-10pm), Saturdays (9am-5pm*) and Sundays (9am-5pm*). Hours may vary slightly as this person determines what works best for them and the school, but this position will work an estimated 20 hours per week. (**Saturday and Sunday hours include a 1 hour, unpaid, lunch break from 12-1pm*)

Duties:

- Basic cleaning of the public areas of the lodge before, during and after lessons
- Restocking restroom supplies as needed during lessons
- Taking out garbage/recycle as needed during and after lessons
- Monitor hot chocolate refilling as needed
- Shoveling snow from walkways and decks as needed
- Set up and tear down of class signs, fences or obstacle course
- Customer service- help answering questions, or listening to customers, selling merchandise or lift tickets from store located in lodge, sitting with students needing to come inside
- Working with management team as needed to ensure flow of lodge and customer experience is met

Requirements & Accessibility:

- Minimum age: 16 years old at time of employment (per Washington State Department of Labor & Industries)
- Able to lift 40+ lbs
- Ability to be on feet for long periods of time
- Basic math (addition, subtraction)
- Basic computer skills (ability to learn POS on tablet, possibly some light typing/printing)
- Strong sense of customer service and providing the best experience possible
- Ability to work with cleaning products (chemicals and scented products)
- Ability to walk up and down stairs and on uneven ground (our building is not ADA accessible, and has multiple sets of stairs of varying widths and tread depths; outdoor environment includes snow and of varying consistency.)

Benefits:

This is a seasonal, hourly position. Wages DOE. Benefits include a deeply discounted season pass and access to industry discounts. December 1 – May 1 accommodations are negotiable as a benefit of this position. Additional benefit is having Monday-Friday afternoon off to free ski/board, or have additional employment.
